- 1. The Gates will be opened at 5:50pm to allow children to access the pitch area, we aim to start the session at 5:55pm prompt, by 6pm at the latest.
- 2. To avoid congestion and allow the follow-on session to commence on time we need to vacate the facility by 7pm. Coaches will therefore end their sessions by 6:55pm at the latest.
- 3. The follow-on sessions have agreed to commence 5 minutes later (7:05pm) to ensure we avoid any clashes. And will access via a different gate.
- 4. When you arrive please send your children straight into the pitch area, they will be training in the location as detailed on the training location map Your coaches will share the location map if you haven't seen it.
- 5. Parents can check in via the NHS app poster during the session, please ensure you do this. If you don't have the app then give your contact details to Emily or one of her Covid/Welfare support parents.
- 6. Please exit at the end of the session via the same gate, leaving promptly. Do not hang around to chat as this will result in congestion issues with the follow-on group.
- 7. Ensure you social distance at all times including approaching and leaving the venue and do not congregate in groups of more than 6. If the viewing area is full there are plenty of safe areas outside and around the perimeter fence where you can safely watch the session.
- 8. Don't forget the correct CLEAN footwear (no blades, trainers, dimples or metal studs)
- 9. The coaches will have a designated safe zone for each child to place their water bottle, sanitiser etc which they will return to at appropriate intervals during the session.
